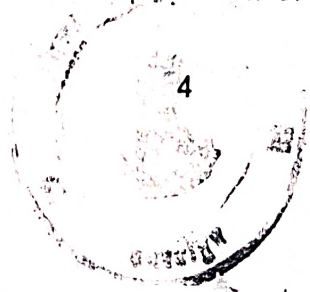
Where the Settler has contributed a sum of Rs. 5000.00 (Rupees Five Thousand) and the amount has been expended in Trust of Public Utility and accordingly it has been declared and agreed by the parties as under:

1. **That the name of the Trust shall be Vasundhara.**
2. That the office of the Trust shall be situated at Mohanpur Road Samastipur, or at any other place as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time.
3. It will operate for the welfare & utility of public.
4. That the object for which the Trust is created are:
  - a. National unity and International peace and amity Communal and social harmony and brotherhood.
  - b. Promotion and extension of appropriate technology, including systems having renewable sources of energy.
  - c. To take up programmes for ensuring protection of environment, Biodiversity conservation for regeneration of natural resources degraded due to our past neglects.
  - d) To start, maintain and assist any relief measure in those parts which are or become subjected to natural calamities such as Floods, Fire, Drought, Famine, Cyclone, tsunami, Volcano, Earthquakes, Storm accident etc.
  - e. Promotion of cottage and small scale industries by taking up action research work.
  - f. Promotion and progress of agriculture and animal husbandry.
  - g. To undertake evaluation of economic and social projects.
  - h. To take up programmes in which Science and Technology may have major role in improving life, working conditions and opportunities for gainful employment of women and socially weaker section. To work for economic development of the poor sections of the Society for eradication of poverty, illiteracy, injustice, deprivation and backwardness. to take up enforcement of prohibition and initiate people's movement against, alcoholist and drug abuse as well as human trafficking.
  - i. To take up programmes for accelerating pace of rural development by application of science and technology (techniques and technologies for cost reduction, improving productivity etc.) specially in the field of water exploration, watershed and purification, sanitation, cost housing, agriculture and animal husbandry as well as engineering sources.
  - j. Propagation and promotion of work centres and

pleadings including complaints, written statements, counter affidavit, applications, petitions,

affidavits etc. in all the proceedings by or against the Trust shall be signed and verified by the Chairman.

In Witness whereof the settlor has executed these presents on the day, month and year above mentioned in the presence of the following witness:

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cooperation of any kind or others and giving organization etc. in the furtherance of the objects of organization.

k. To undertake programmes which ensures raising of income levels and expanding employment opportunities of the weaker sections of society specially of those leaving below poverty lines and women by involving participants in the planning, implementation and maintenance of activities taken up. To provide training for better and modern/up to date Technical farming, Fisheries, Poltry form, Animal husbandry, Horticulture Training of Handicrafts, Fine arts and other useful arts, crafts including the establishment and maintenance of Shipla-Shikhalayas, Kala-Kendra and other small industries by virtue of which people fight against poverty by self-employment.

l. To take up all formal and non formal education programme for the promotion of education.

m. To undertake basic research in the areas of health, education, family welfare, Agriculture, Environment and social engineering.

n. To undertake implementable activities related to the stated areas by creating network of sub-offices at various geographical locations, if required.

o. To undertake training, educational campaigns as part of strategic implementation plan.

p. To undertake activities that are oriented towards the promotion of family welfare, including the delivery of family welfare services.

q. To take up programme for the protection of birds and animals.

r. To encourage people specially women and those belonging to weaker section to develop the livelihood, income and employment generating opportunities and activities by taking up various income generation schemes like fisheries, dairy, agriculture, floriculture, horticulture, cottage and small industries, vending in the form of SHG's.

s. To set up educational facilities for girls, minorities, SC, ST, OBC's and other weaker section of the society.

t. To set up old age home, orphanage, reform homes for socially neglected children, women, Handicapped persons etc.

u. To raise or acquire funds or property from central government, state government, foreign agencies, non-government agencies, charitable trusts by way of donations or grants or contributions or by taking loan from public and private

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financial institutions. The funds, properties, assets and all other resources, present and future, of the society shall be utilised for any or all the purpose or objects of the society as stated above and also for similar activities in furtherance of ideals of truth and non violence.

- v. To promote and advertise various systems of medicines.
- w. To organise various kinds of professional and vocational education programmes for unemployed persons.
- x. To organise seminars, conference, meeting etc. on human rights, cultural heritage, environmental conservation etc.
- y. To work for the welfare of Consumers and protect their rights.
- z. To Organise RCH Programme and Programme on ISM & The trustees may from time to time frame schemes and rules and regulations to carry out the objects of the Trust and for managing the affairs of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects and purposes of the trust and to vary the same from time to time as the trustees may in their discreption deem fit and proper.

**5. Funds.**

That the amount settled by the Settlor on Trust today amounting to Rupees Five thousand will be corpus of the Trust and the Trustees are hereby further empowered to collect donations from Government, Public, Public Undertaking and other persons in the manner they desire.

That the corpus of funds of the Trust not immediately required are to be deposited in the bank or to be invested in any Government Security to which the Trust is entitled.

That the Trustees are empowered to maintain bank account and to authorise any two Trustees to operate on the same. That is agreed and declared that no part of the Trust fund shall be utilised by the settlors or Trustees for their own purpose nor they will be entitled to borrow the funds of the Trust at any rate.

**6. Management**

The Trust will have a general body whose members will be from the different section of the society. The membership charge will be Rs.-100/- (One Hundred Only) out of general committee.

That the Trust shall be managed by the Board of Trustees. That the Settlor of the Trust have agreed to act as Trustee and testimony therefore have signed this Deed of Trust. That the

maximum number of Trustees shall be 7 and not less than five at any time. That the Trustees will hold their meeting at least in a year That the presence of five Trustees personally will be the quorum for the meeting. That any Trustee may resign from the Trusteeship and the Trustees in that meeting are empowered to accept the same. That the trustees are empowered to fill up the vacancy in the Board of Trustees. That a person of the age of 18 years or beyond having interest in the Educational, Cultural and Social activities can be taken as a Trustee by the remaining trustees, That the Trustees who are to found to work derogatory to the interest of the Trust may be removed by two third majority of the trustees in their meeting but before that the Trustees are required to give notice to such Trustee for the lapses on his particulars. That any Trustee who is leaving India for good or who remains absent continuously in three meeting without permission can be removed from the Trusteeship of the Trust. That the Trustees are empowered to reimburse for the expenses incurred for the Trust and its activities out of their own funds.

### 7. Accounts

That the Trustees shall maintain true and fair accounts of all receipts and payments of the Trust and accounts so maintained shall remain at the office of the trust.

That the accounting year of the Trust will be from April to March every year and the first accounts of the Trust shall close on 31st March, 2009. That the Trustees are empowered to appoint a Chartered Accountant for audit of the accounts of the Trust and to fix their remuneration of such auditors. That the accounts so prepared and audited shall be placed before the special Meeting of the Trustees within three months of the closure of the accounts along with the report of the Auditors. That the accounts so audited shall be printed and published and may be sent to donors of the Trust and the Trustees.

### 8. Trust meetings

That the general body of the Trustees shall meet once in a year for the purpose of the Trust and taking for the management of the Trust and its funds. The executive committee shall meet at the interval of four months. That the decisions are to be taken by majority. That personal presence of five Trustees will be the quorum for a meeting convened by a notice of 7 days

### 9. Special meetings

That the Trust will have in a year its special meetings

before 30th June of every year in which the audited accounts of the Trust are to be placed before the special Meeting to approve and adopt such accounts and the report .

**10. Investments**

That the funds collected for the Trust shall be utilised for carrying out the Trust or acquiring the capital assets or constructing the building etc. for the purpose of the Trust.

That in case any surplus remains with the Trust the same will be invested in the Government Securities permitted for the Trust or to remain in the Bank in F.D. or S.B. Accounts.

That no part of the funds shall be invested in share or advance for loan to other excepting the loan scholarship granted by the Trust while framing rules for the same.

**11. Nature of Trust**

That the nature of the Trust is Public Chritable Trust and the benefit of the Trust shall be available to the beneficiaries without any distinction of cast, creed, religion or sex.

**12. Amendment in Trust Deed**

That the Trust Deed can be amended by two-thirds majority of the Trustees in a meeting specially called for the purpose by giving 14 days notice for the purpose and the resolution passed by such majority as circulated with or without notification shall be final.

**13. Powers of the Trustees**

That overall control of the Trust shall be in the Trustees who will exercise their power and control through the Executive Committee of the Trustees appointed by them for the purpose or through the office bearers elected by themselves out of them.

That the Executive Committee or of Office bearers shall have the following the powers in general.

To raise, collect or arrange for the donations for the benefit of the Trust and to invest such funds from time to time.

To decide about the educational, social, cultural , envirmetal activities to be undertaken by the Trust.

To make rules for running of the Institutions or giving appointments or appointment of the officers and teachers as well as

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for the meeting held by them.

The Trustees are empowered to appoint and terminate the employees of the Trust.

The Trustees are further empowered to open and operate Bank Account or accounts with any scheduled Bank and may exercise/authorise either two of them to operate the same jointly .

The Trustees are also empowered to donate the funds to a Trust having similar objects.

**14. Office bearers**

01. For the smooth running of the Trust the Trustees are empowered to elect the following office bearers out of themselves :

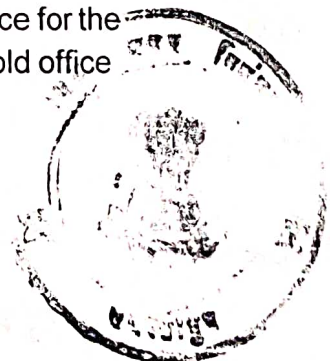
- (i) Chairman
- (ii) Vice-Chairman
- (iii) Secretary
- (iv) Joint Secretary
- (v) Treasurer

One executive member shall be nominated by the chairman and one shall be elected by the general body.

That the office-bearers so elected by them shall hold office for a period of Five year and every fith year in the month of june there will be fresh election but the retiring office bearers may be re-elected in the meeting called for the election of the office bearers.

**15. Chairman**

That the Chairman of the Trust will be the virtual Head of the Trustees and will preside over all the meetings of trustees as well as chairman of the Executive committee. In the event of vacancy of the chairman caused by the death, resignation or otherwise the remaining trustees shall elect as chairman from amongst themseleves a condidate who gets the highest number of votes of the trustees present and voting of a meeting specially called for the purpose. The Chirman so elected shall hold office for the period for five years. The chairman so elected shall hold office



for the period for five years. The chairman so elected shall hold office for the period for five years. However, the Chairman so elected shall be eligible for re-election.

**16. Vice-Chairman**

The Vice-Chairman of the Trust shall act in the absence of the Chairman and in his absence all meetings are to be preside by the Vice-Chairman. In case of the absence of the Vice-Chairman also the Trustees are empowered to elect anyone out of them to preside over the meeting. The vice-Chairman shall be nominated by the Chairman for a period of five years with the consultation of trustees from amongst the board of trustees. The Vice Chairman shall be eligible for renomination. The Vice-Chairman shall assist the chairman in discharging his duties and do the duties as assigned to him by the Chairman from time to time.

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**17. Secretary**

The Board of Trustees are empowered to elect a Secretary out of themself to manage the affairs of the Trust and to look after its day-to-day business. All records of this Trust shall remain in the custody of the secretary. The Secretary is entitled to call for the meeting of the Trust under the permission of the Chairman.

The Secretary of the Trust will be the custodian of the Trust and work as the Chief Functionary of the Trust.

The Secretary shall be empowered to represent Trust in all the cases of the court and other activities anywhere as an authority.

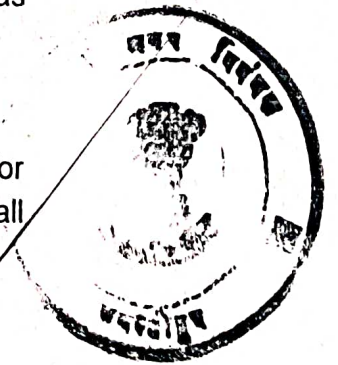
The Secretary shall prepare the Annual Report of the Trust and place the same before the Board of Trustees.

**18. Joint Secretary**

The joint secretary shall be nominated by the Chairman for a period of five years with the consultation of Trustees from amongst the board of Trustees, The Joint secretary shall assist the secretary in discharging his duties and to do the duties as assigned to him by Chairman time to time.

**19. Treasurer**

The Trustees are empowered to elcet one Treasurer for holding the office for a period of five years. The Treasurer shall



be responsible for keeping all records and maintain the account of all receipt and payments. He will be required to prepare the annual budget of the Trust and will place it before the special meeting of the Trust for the approval. The Treasurer will also be required to prepare the final accounts to get the same audited by the Auditors appointed by the Board of Trustees and will place the same before the special meeting of the Trustees.

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**20. Winding up**

That the Trust can wind up its affairs if it finds it difficult to run the activities of the Trust any more but no part of the fund of the Trust and its property shall be back to the Trustees.

that in case the Trust decides to wind up its activities in may handover the corpus of the Trust And its assests and liabilities to another Trust having same or similar objects.

That the Board of Trustees shall call an extra ordinary meeting of the Trustees for the purpose by giving 14 days notice to the Trustees and a resolution passed by two-thirds majority of the Trustees present shall be the requirement for the winding fo the Trust.

**21. Audit & accounts**

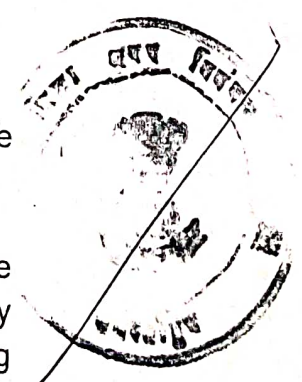
The accounts so maintained shall be closed every year on 31th March on which date and Income and Expenditure Account for the year and Balance Sheet as on the date of closing shall be prepared to be placed before the meeting of Trustees after getting the same audited.

The accounts of the Trust are to be audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Trustees in their meeting. The auditor so appointed shall hold his officer till the next auditor is appointed.

General :-

The Property of the trust whether movable or immovable shall be vested in the Board of Trustees.

(a) The number of Exective members of the Executive Committee may be increased, if necessary, by two thirds majority of the Board of Trustees, present and voting in a meeting



especially called for the purpose.

(b) The Executive Committee shall have the power to frame bye-laws of the trust in respect of any institution of committee set up by the Trust and in respect of any matter within the trust.

(c) The Executive Committee shall be competent to affiliate other organisation/Institution on such terms and condition as approved by the Board of Trustees.

(d) The quorum of any meeting of the Board of Trustees, Executive Committee or any committee or sub-committee shall be one-third or member if the quorum is not complete, the meeting shall be adjourned and reconvened by the Chairman There shall be no quorum for the adjourned meeting.

(e) The Executive Committee shall be competent to open branches, offices of institution outside Samastipur.

(f) Any member of the Trust or Executive Committee or any office bearer may resign at any time from the office or membership held by him/her by writing to the Chairman. The Chairman may address his resignation to the Executive committee through the secretary of the Trust. The resignation of tendered shall become effective from the date it is accepted by the Executive Committee.

(g) The Executive Committee shall open or caused to be open Bank Account/accounts in the name of the Trust in a schedule bank. All such accounts shall be operated by the signatures of any two of the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer, the Treasurer.

(h) The financial year of the Trust for the purpose of maintaining and closing accounts and for the purpose of budget shall commence from the month of April and ends with the month of March every calendar year.

(i) All deeds and other documents to be executed by or on behalf of the Trust shall be done, by the Chairman and the Trust may be sued in the name of the Chairman of the Trust. All
